To become authorized to deliver B.C. Class 1 MELT, driver training schools must do the following:

1	<p>Review the curriculum framework - MELT-curriculum-framework.pdf</p> <p>Ensure your school meets all of the criteria in the 'Course Standards' section of the curriculum framework.</p>	
2	<p>Ensure your instructors have completed the required MELT Orientation Course (MOC), and Approved Instructor Theory (AIT) course (if applicable), so they have the necessary Class 1 MELT designations.</p> <p>All existing instructors must complete the courses listed here - Instructor Requirements Air brake driver training instructors must register for the AIT course – MELT Air brake theory information</p>	
3	<p>Become authorized to deliver B.C. Class 1 MELT course.</p> <p>Contact ICBC Driver Training Industry Support to request an application package and your personalized MELT agreement between your school and ICBC. See contact information at the bottom of this form.</p>	
4	<p>Complete all of the following forms on behalf of your school:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> MELT Course Outline (MV7609) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The course outline details how your school will deliver the Class 1 MELT course to ensure all of the required curriculum is covered. 5	<p>Deliver B.C Class 1 MELT courses.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Upon approval your school will be listed on dtcbc.com as an authorized Class 1 MELT school. • You will be issued a duplicate driver training school licence with a Class 1 MELT designation. • You will be issued Class 1 MELT Declaration of Completion forms (MV2970) for issuance to students who successfully complete the Class 1 MELT course. • Please note: you cannot issue Class 1 MELT Declaration of Completion forms or advertise that you offer the approved B.C. Class 1 MELT course prior to receiving ICBC approval.
