

# Introducing the Clinical Advisory Group



Effective May 1, 2021, Enhanced Care coverage will provide anyone injured in a crash with access to the care they need for as long as they need it. To support with delivering this new model, ICBC has established a **Clinical Advisory Group**.

The Clinical Advisory Group is a diverse team of **highly-experienced medical and clinical experts**, who will be contracted on a part-time basis by ICBC. These experts will provide support to ICBC claim representatives so they can better understand the nuances of each customer's injuries and make funding decisions that are clinically informed and justified.

The Clinical Advisory Group will consist of registered health professionals, which include physicians and health care providers such as physiotherapists, occupational therapists, chiropractors and psychologists.

ICBC will continue to advertise Clinical Advisory Group positions through BC Bid.



The Clinical Advisory Group **will**:

- Provide opinions on patient treatment methods and effectiveness
- Provide evidence-based advice on return to function planning
- Clarify available medical/ clinical information



The Clinical Advisory Group will **not**:

- Conduct examinations (in-person or other)
- Make claims related decisions
- Conduct any form of medical legal work
