On Feb 6, 2020 a new care-based insurance model was announced. Called Enhanced Care coverage, the new model provides dramatically more care and coverage for anyone injured in a crash regardless of fault.

A NEW WAY OF DOING AUTO INSURANCE

While several reforms have been introduced to improve the auto insurance system in B.C. they have not been enough to provide long-term affordability and stability to auto insurance. That's why we are working together to bring in this new way of doing auto insurance. Enhanced Care coverage will build on the changes by providing British Columbians access to significantly enhanced medical care, recovery, and wage loss benefits if they are injured in a crash, regardless of who is at fault.

Modelled on the success of no-fault systems in Manitoba and Saskatchewan, Enhanced Care will provide the right level of **care and support** to customers, based on the nature of their injuries.
