Vehicle licensing & insurance bulletin

Licensing and insurance documentation and decals during COVID-19 outbreak

With the COVID-19 situation rapidly evolving, ICBC has set protocols to help British Columbians access vehicle licensing and insurance services they need without in-person contact.

During this outbreak, Autoplan brokers will be able to process renewals over the phone. Therefore, some BC motorists temporarily may not have regular documents or decals. Instead, some B.C. motorists may have:

- digital copies of B.C. insurance certificates
- printed copies of insurance certificates not on regulated format paper, and
- recently expired decals (decals may be mailed for phone transactions and could be delayed).

Motorists are still required to have a valid licence and insurance. Law enforcement will be able to access motorists' current licence and insurance through the police CPIC and ICBC databases.

These new procedures are effective immediately and remain in place until further notice.
